The submission of a competitive full paper or abstract (with subsequently submitted full paper) for review means that the paper is original and has not been previously copyrighted, published, presented, or submitted for publication or presentation. Outstanding papers will be selected and recognized at the meeting luncheon on January 31, 2025.

Symposia, Panels, Tutorials, and Workshops

Proposals for symposia, panels, tutorials, and workshops must be at least two (2) pages long describing what you intend to do and why it would be of interest and importance to members of the Institute. Submissions should follow the General Guidelines detailed here although considerable latitude will be allowed as to the content and format of these sessions. You must provide your own specialized computers or other equipment needed for the session (SEDSI will provide projectors). All participants in symposia, tutorials, and workshops must register and attend the meeting.

Please note that all papers, presentations, and panel sessions are held in-person. No virtual sessions will be available.

2. The submission to be uploaded must be in an editable format (such as .docx) and should include the title and, optionally, a one-paragraph abstract between the title and the body of the paper. The names of the authors should NOT be included on this submitted paper for the review process. At least one author of an accepted paper is required to register for, and present at, the conference.
